Continuing Requirements

Major continuing support requirements are:

- Any major in-service problems or major accidents in the world fleet are to be advised immediately to the AUF.
- Details of English speaking engineering and operational contacts within the TL Ultralights Factory are to be kept current with the AUF.
- Detailed and comprehensive continuing airworthiness support for the aircraft is to be made readily available to the AUF as required and the AUF is to be included on the distribution for any maintenance, service and operating bulletins issued to the field. Details of who will supply this data, by what method and advice of any changes to its sourcing is to be advised immediately.
